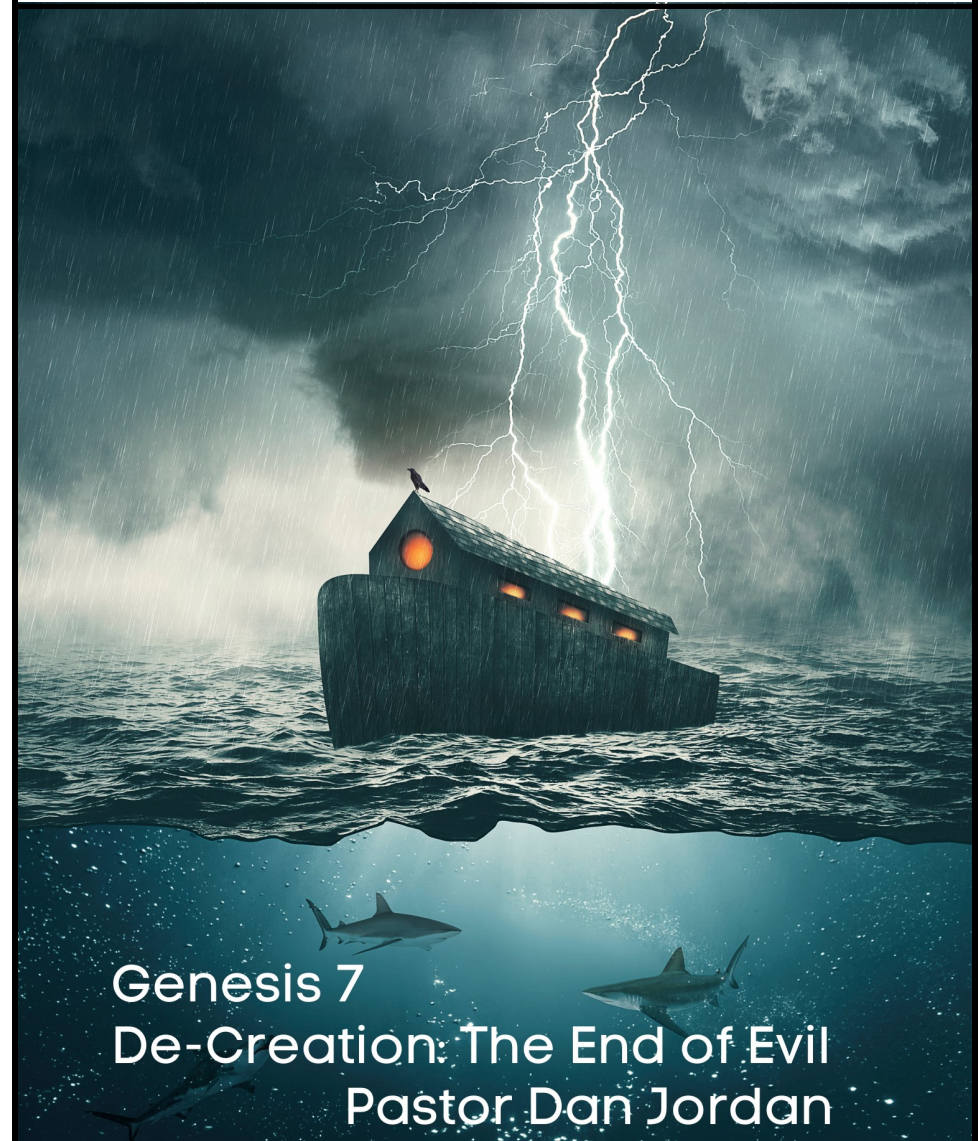

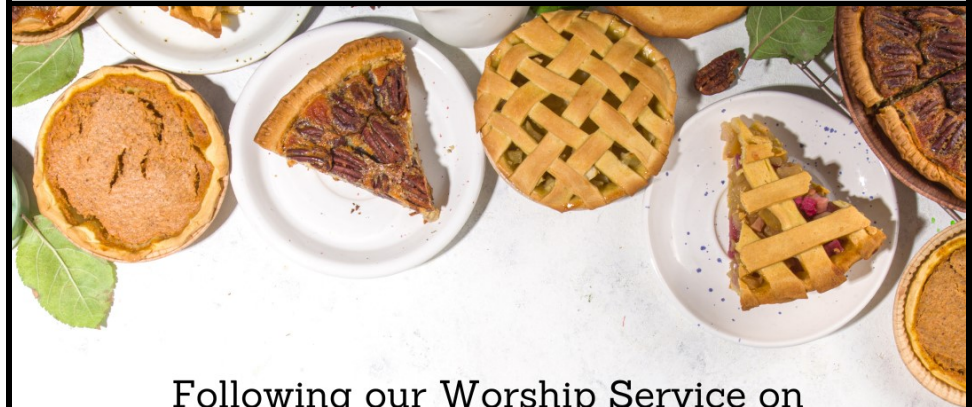
Pick up your shoe boxes and information in the church lobby.
